ASSEMBLE local leaders to remind the public of the importance of security and integrity in the vote count process and raise awareness of threats to the constitutional and legal procedures related to vote counting.



MOBILIZE community voices to applaud election officials for carrying out their sworn, ministerial duties in the face of partisan opposition and support those same officials when they receive pressure to stray from their legal and constitutional obligations.



RESPOND forcefully to any and all actors who encourage illegal action or obstruction related to the constitutionally prescribed vote counting or certification process.
